Shelf life and storage

Estimated shelf life: **12–18 months** from the packaging date.

Store in cool, dry conditions, below **15 °C** and **65 %** relative humidity, in sealed packaging to prevent moisture absorption and quality degradation.

- Copy of the Maritime Bill of Lading (BL)
- Copy of the phytosanitary certificate
- Copy of the sanitary certificate
- Copy of the cargo insurance

– 20% Bank Transfer (TT) upon arrival of the goods at destination.

3. Orders of 6 containers or more (Minimum 3-month contract)

– 30% Bank Transfer (TT) upon issuance of the proforma invoice.

– 70% via Letter of Credit (LC) upon delivery of the following documentation:

- Copy of the Certificate of Origin
- Commercial Invoice
- Copy of the Packing List

- Copy of the Maritime Bill of Lading (BL)
- Copy of the phytosanitary certificate
- Copy of the sanitary certificate
- Copy of the cargo insurance

The Letter of Credit must obligatorily meet the following conditions:

– Confirmed and irrevocable for 100% of the value. Issued by a bank ranked within the world's top 50.

– Identical, without modifications, to the LC draft previously provided to the client by the company.

Time condition

For operations or orders with a duration of less than 3 months, it is mandatory to consult headquarters before offering any payment terms.
